

Some Property Owners Are Receiving A Request For Updated Agricultural Applications To Be Filed With The Appraisal District

Some property owners have recently received a letter from the Medina County Appraisal District requesting a current application for 1-d-1 (Open Space) Agricultural Use Appraisal. The Appraisal District is in the process of updating its records and needs to obtain the most current information on these properties.

During the most recent Methods and Assistance Program Review of the appraisal district records performed by the Texas State Comptroller of Public Accounts Property Tax Assistance Division, it was discovered that some properties receiving the Agricultural Appraisal prior to 2020 have outdated information or an application is not on file in the District's records. In order to be in compliance with the State requirements regarding these forms, the District is requesting updated applications from an estimated 1500 property owners.

Property owners may receive solicitation to have the 1-d-1 Agricultural Application completed for them. The Appraisal District will help property owners complete the application for free.
